Australian Breed Society

Over the years we have been building a small but loyal group of members in Australia. In recent times their efforts to import semen and embryos have been thwarted by diseases in the UK restricting imports and a lack of suitable germplasm.

A few weeks ago Australia lifted some of the import restrictions on germplasm and a shipment of semen will shortly be on it's way out to them for crossbreeding.

The Australian contingent is setting up it's own Breed Society (the Australian English Longhorn Society) and we will give them all the help and support they need.

If you are thinking about flushing cows to preserve your own herd genetics for the future then please consider the export market - there is a real demand for embryos in Australia and New Zealand.

Who knows, one day we might have a Society visit to Australia!

BREEDS AT RISK REGISTER



DEFRA Breeds at Risk Register

The Breeds at Risk register was set up in 2002 as a mechanism for the executive agency Animal Health (formally the State Veterinary Service) to identify holdings where there were 'nucleus' flocks and herds of Farm Animal Genetic Resources. This register was to be used to help identify farms which might be spared from contiguous cull in the case of another outbreak of Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD).

Members of the Longhorn Cattle Society can apply for registration. Your application is then verified by the Society against your the pedigree database to confirm that you do in fact own the required number of registered animals of your breed. Farms verified on the BARR register are eligible for special protection under any future FMD contiguous cull.

Extension of the Register

RBST are delighted to be able to report that the RBST and BPA (British Pig Association) with the help of the National Standing Committee on Farm Animal Genetic Resources have managed to negotiate two significant modifications the Breeds at Risk Register.

- The minimum or 'nucleus' flock and herd sizes has been removed. This means that members with smaller herds can now apply and be verified as keepers.
- The register has been extended for use in the case of any disease for which a compulsory slaughter policy might be implemented.

Inclusion on the register does not guarantee that your animals will be spared. Each farm will have to demonstrate good biosecurity, good movement records and that their animal registrations are up to date. Outbreaks of each disease will have to be monitored individually and the risk of sparing your herd assessed. However, inclusion on the register will be the first step towards a possible derogation.

Offley Hoo is an award winning farm in Hertfordshire which is part of the Kings Walden Estate. Jon Birchall is the Farm Manager. Jon is a finalist for the 2010 Farmers Weekly Award for Countryside Farmer of the Year and was awarded the Chilterns Environment Award for 2009. Our Traditional Quality Meat business won the Countryside Alliance Local Food Award for East Anglia 2009. The farm grows wheat for Hovis and Warburtons and rears native and rare breed Longhorn cattle, Wiltshire Horn sheep and Middle White and other traditional pigs. The farm sells delicious well hung meat direct to the customers.

The **Roxton Herd** was started with the purchase of three in-calf cows in October 1988. We now run approximately 20 cows which is as many as we can comfortably house overwinter. I would like to leave them outside but by mid-October in most years they start to poach the parkland badly. Heifers surplus to requirements are sold if good enough to breed, a few cattle are sold privately after hanging for 3 or4 weeks and the remainder are sold as fat or stores. On average steers are fit to kill at 25 to 28 months.
