#### **John Spalton**

It is with great sadness that we learn of the death on 7<sup>th</sup> May of John Spalton from Sutton on the Hill, Derbyshire. John died at the age of 59 years after a short illness, making his loss all the more tragic for his wife Beryl, and his son and daughter.

John was a larger than life character in many ways, especially in the world of Longhorns. In a relatively short time John had made a huge impression on our breed.

The Bejon Prefix is well known and respected as a source of good quality cattle, and John won many prizes in the show ring.

I remember meeting John some years ago for the first time at Derby Show. It was his first venture into the show ring and his young bull had lost its ring. Luckily we had a spare one with us which we gave him. He was thrilled and said he had obviously gone into the right breed because we appeared to be a friendly lot.

John taught at the Kirk Hallam Community Technology College in Ilkeston. If you have a look at their website you will see how deeply he involved the pupils in the day to day tasks on his farm, over the years educating many young people about what actually goes into providing the food that they eat, and using the Longhorns as a tremendous teaching aid.

We shall miss his kind words, ready wit, deep thought and fierce competitiveness.

His death is a tragedy for his family, his College, all of his many friends and not least for us his fellow Longhorn breeders.

#### BEJON DISPERSAL SALE

Purchasers travelled from across the country and Ireland to support the dispersal of the Bejon Longhorn herd, taken as a result of John Spalton's recent and untimely death.

The cattle were transported to Worcester Market for convenience of sale and a packed sale ring again saw demand for Longhorn hit an almost phenomenal level.

Cows with calves at foot were hotly contested peaking at a creditable 2,100gns for a seven year old cow by the homebred bull Bejon Boris and with a bull calf at foot being secured by Reading Agricultural Consultants for a client in the Home Counties. They were keen purchasers at the sale taking a total of 5 animals including the Stud Bull "Gorse Moonman" at 2,500gns. Two other cows with heifer calves at foot, also by Bejon Boris both levelled at 1900gns to join the newly formed herd.

Served heifers were closely followed selling to a top of 1,500gns to Pat Melvin, Castlerea, Ireland.

Unserved heifers were in the spotlight throughout peaking at 2,200gns for an 18 month old Bejon Dickie daughter, Dickie having won numerous prizes including Reserve Breed Champion at Newark, 2005. She was taken by Mrs JD Botham, Brough, East Yorkshire.
