*The Hotel is mentioned in the Domesday Book, although all that is left of the original structure is the Norman Mill Tower and two water wheels. The current Hotel, sited next to the River Trent, has a variety of rooms, offered at a range of prices, so **members should book their rooms direct with the Hotel by telephoning 01332 810649** to ensure they get accommodation suitable to their requirements and price range. The website gives an excellent overview of the variety of the rooms available. **Please let the Hotel know you are booking as part of the Longhorn Cattle Society weekend for the preferential rates.***

There are rooms in the main hotel, rooms in the adjacent cottages and two houses that are fully equipped holiday cottages if you wish to book in with a group of friends or extend your stay.

Rooms vary in price:

£85 per night B&B for a single occupancy room in the cottages,

£95 per night B&B twin or double occupancy in the cottages,

£105 per night B&B single occupancy in the main hotel,

£115 per night B&B double occupancy in the main hotel

The holiday houses are available but must be booked early to secure - please contact the Hotel for rates.

The owner of the Hotel also owns Donington Hall, home to the Norton Motorcycle Company. The Hall and factory are about 1/2 a mile from the Hotel and the factory is open for tours on Fridays. Visit the Norton website to find out more and book a tour, if this is your thing!

Visit to Blackbrook Longhorns, Springbarrow Lodge, Swannymote Road, Coalville, Leicestershire, LE67 5UT

The Blackbrook Herd was established in 1989, following a desire to set up a beef suckler herd to run concurrently with the then dairy herd. John and Pat had found a family tie with the breed going back over 100 years previously when going through some old farm documents. Add to this the breed's enormous appeal, legendary docility, and the fact that it is one of our oldest and purest natives and every box was ticked. So began the long association with the breed that stole their hearts from the very earliest days. The Stanleys have always been very selective in their purchases and very ruthless in their culling. The cattle now conform to the type they desire leaving them with consistently good offspring and solid foundations for the next few decades.

Stock bulls were selected with great care. Over the years they have brought size, power and strength, together with passing traits to their females of good udders and milking ability. The Stanleys look for an animal of quality with good locomotion, feet, and overall balance. Suckler dams should be easy care and within the Blackbrook Herd that is essential.

The meat from the Longhorn has won accolades by all of the top Chef's including Heston Blumenthal, Jock Zonfrillo, and Gregg Wallace. The Blackbrook Herd itself won the title of 'Best Meat in Britain' (Country Life) in 2012.

Blackbrook Longhorns were a familiar sight up and down the country in the showing for a period of 26 years. During that time they took six National Championships as well as prestigious Interbreed Championships. The herd has won the Midland Herd Competition for an outstanding total of 18 times. The herd participates in the Society's Type Classification Scheme and has the most number of cattle classified EX in one herd.

Over the last few years John & Pat have been concentrating of the export of their genetics to countries across the World - America, Australia, New Zealand, Germany, France etc.
