

6. Vendors shall have the right to place a reserve price on any or all of their cattle. This must be notified to the Auctioneers in writing, preferably before the commencement of the Sale and will be treated as a reserve and not a guide.
7. All transactions either by Auction or by Private Treaty following the Sale must be passed through the Auctioneers' Sale Office
8. Straw for bedding will be provided, but Vendors must provide their own feedstuffs, buckets etc.
9. All registered cattle will be sold in guineas with a commission rate of 5%.
10. **PRE MOVEMENT TB TESTING** - All cattle over 42 days of age must have passed a TB test within the previous 60 days of the movement. All cattle from either England, Wales or Scotland **must be** pre movement tested, irrespective of area.
11. All cattle forward for sale must either be in a CHeCS recognised Health Scheme or are individually tested for Leptospirosis, BVD, Johnes and IBR. Testing for Neospora is highly recommended. All entries must be accompanied by the completed health declaration.
12. Each animal forward at the sale must be exposed for sale by auction before any private sale shall be permitted or recognized by the Society or the Auctioneers.
13. Disbudded cattle may be shown at Society sales.
14. The vendor must present for sale by Auction any animal catalogued for sale. Where animals catalogued cannot be brought forward a 'like for like' substitution can be made up to 48 hours prior to the start of the sale. Should a substitution be made then a veterinary certificate should be submitted for the withdrawn animal and a £50+VAT (£60.00) fee will be payable for the entry of the substitute animal.
15. Any vendor not bringing cattle for sale on the day should provide a veterinary certificate for the absent animal or will be subject to a fine of £50 + VAT (£60.00) when entering a subsequent sale. The Society shall reserve the right to refuse entries at subsequent Longhorn sales.
16. A transfer fee of £15 + VAT (£18.00) shall be paid by both the vendor and the purchaser. Pedigree certificates will only be transferred on payment of the transfer fee.
17. Small dispersals will be permitted after the Society sale at Worcester. These dispersals shall be catalogued separately and sold after the official sale. The Society reserve the right to inspect cattle before a dispersal will be permitted on the same day and at the same location as a Society sale

1. The Sale is held subject to the Regulations as printed in this notice and also to the LAA Conditions of Sale and the Auctioneers General Conditions of Sale.
2. Entry of Classes 1-6 is open to any full member of the Society provided their subscriptions are up to date and all stock must be fully registered or notified within the Society's official notification of birth time limit.
3. The Society reserve the right to inspect any cattle entered for sale to assess their suitability
4. All entries must be made on the official entry forms and must be completed throughout. Entries must be accompanied by the ENTRY FEE and the relevant REGISTRATION CERTIFICATES. Entries without the relevant fees and certificates will not be accepted. The Society reserves the right to refuse or restrict entries if it is felt necessary, at the closing date for entries
5. There will be two sections:
 - a) A section for led and shown cattle
 - b) A section for sale only cattle which may be led or unled

ENTRY FEE (Classes 1-5): £30 plus VAT (£36.00) per entry

All bulls MUST be haltered trained, rung and led
