Below are the health requirements for BVD, IBR, Lepto, Johne's and Neospora.

Members wishing to enter animals to the sale are advised to discuss the content of this form with their veterinary practice.

This Health Testing requirement should be seen as a minimum and members are encouraged to disclose any additional information on animals and herd health status in the catalogue and/or at the sale.

CHeCS approved health schemes:

Vendors are encouraged to belong to a CHeCS approved health scheme and/or BVDFree England.

Herds holding an accreditation are exempted from blood testing for the specific disease. For Johnes's, R1 Accreditation is required

Members wishing to be exempt from blood testing must apply to their Health Scheme provider for an Accreditation report prior to the closing date of the sale and send a copy to the Society office (prior to the closing date) for verification and for the details to be listed in the catalogue

Blood Testing:

Blood testing is required for all animals unless having CHeCS approved health scheme herd accreditation or herd accreditation from BVDFree England in the case of BVD.

Blood tests should occur less than 60 days prior to the sale and results must be submitted prior to the sale.

Specific requirements are as follows:

BVD: Negative blood test required for BVD antigen.

IBR: Negative blood test required (if animal has been vaccinated, must be with a marker vaccine and tested accordingly).

Lepto: Negative blood test required unless animal has been vaccinated (there is no marker vaccine for Lepto).

If vaccinated vaccine batch number and date required

Johne's: Negative blood test required for all animals 2 years old and over.

Faecal test would be permitted if blood test timing is not compatible with TB test timing.

Johnes's tests sensitivities are poor and, therefore, membership of health scheme is preferred.

Neospora: Recommended for all females.
