Spring Show & Sale, Worcester, 16 May 2020

- Vendors are encouraged to be accredited members of a CHeCS approved health scheme and/or #BVD Free England and details will be listed in the catalogue. Herds holding health scheme accreditation are exempted from blood testing for the specific disease. Members must apply to their Health Scheme provider for an animal health declaration card prior to the sale.
- Vendors not accredited via a health scheme wishing to blood test should do so not more than 60 days prior to the sale.

Where in a health scheme or testing the following specific requirements are as follows:

- **BVD:** Negative blood test for Antigen. If vaccinating then this must be given post a clear blood test.
- **IBR:** Negative blood test. When vaccinating a marker vaccine must be used
- **Leptospirosis:** Negative blood test. If vaccinating then this must be given post a clear blood test.
- **Johnes:** Negative blood test for all animals two years old and over. R1 rating is required for accreditation. Faecal test would be permitted if blood test timing is not compatible with TB test timing. Johnes' test sensitivities are poor and therefore membership of a health scheme is preferred.
- **Neospora:** testing recommended for all females.
- In all cases vendors must test all animals over 42 days old on the day of the sale for TB, irrespective of home testing interval.
- All animals must be free from any contagious disease such as warts, ringworm, lice and mange. Where animals still exhibit signs following treatment a veterinary certificate is required.
