We had a real international flavour to this year's event with members coming from Germany, Holland and Australia. They all extended their visits to the UK and visited other Longhorn members across the country.

We started off at John Colegrave's Wykham Park Farm Shop and Longhorns. Members saw a butchery demonstration, were able to look round the Farm Shop and bakery and saw the yarded finishing cattle. We then went to Broughton Castle, seat of Lord and Lady Saye and Sele where the Wykham cows and calves were grazing.

We had the use of the medieval Great Hall for lunch and the AGM, and then we were treated to an extensive tour of the Castle, with groups being led by Lord and Lady Saye and Sele and their son Martin Fiennes which added a real personal touch.

In the evening we had dinner at our Hotel and were treated to an excellent after-dinner speech by Lord Plumb of Coleshill. The outgoing President John Brigg awarded the President's Award to Society Auctioneer (and former Breed Secretary) Clive Roads. Dr Philip Cleland took over the reins as Society President. A raffle raised £560 for the Henry Plumb Foundation.

On Sunday we visited John and Joshua Brigg's Gorse herd which will celebrate it's 50th anniversary next year and then a number of members repaired to the Charlecote Pheasant Hotel for lunch and the opportunity to see the Vulcan Bomber coming in to land at the adjacent Wellesbourne Airport.

Over 100 members attended all or part of the weekend - an incredible turnout!

FISHWICK BULL SALE

A unique sale of Longhorn Junior bulls was arranged by J Close & Son, Berwick on Tweed on Sunday, coupled with a visit to inspect their Fishwick herd – and the result was an outstanding success!!

Buyers travelled from the northern tip of Scotland to the English Channel coast. Both pedigree and commercial buyers made their presence felt producing a top price of 4,000gns for 'Fishwick One in a Million' by twice Society Bull of the Year 'Fishwick Lord of the Rings'. The bull had recently won 4th in a strong class of Junior bulls at the Society's National Show and was eventually secured by J.M. Sutherland, Caithness, the same buyer taking 'Fishwick Ogliarch' a Blackbrook Nonsuch son at 3,800gns. Both bulls heading north to be used in a large commercial suckler unit to produce Longhorn cross cows.

Two other 'Nonsuch' sons found favour and spirited bidding selling to 2,900gns for 'Fishwick Once in a Lifetime' to RST Farming Ltd, Pulborough, Sussex and 'Fishwick O So Long' also hitting the 2,900gns mark to The Hon. Mrs A Laing, Forres, Morayshire.

'Fishwick Oberon' by 'Lord of the Rings' and out of a Linton cow by 'Southfield Bandit' enjoyed a close following and finally levelled at 2,800gns to Peter Wild, Oldham.

Longhorns In Strong Demand to 3,000gns

The Longhorn Cattle Society's Autumn Show & Sale at Worcester on 26 September again proved that numbers bring buyers and buyers give competition.

A catalogued entry of 106 with a cross section of cows and calves, cerved and un-served heifers and bulls provided a selection for a strong company of buyers and a top of 3,000gns for 'Wellhead Orton Lad' a 16 month old bull by 'Raincliffe Harry' out of a homebred cow from Nicky Luckett's Cumbria based herd and secured by Mrs Y Ferguson, Steyning, W. Sussex.

Bulls were a selective trade but those that met buyers' criteria were closely followed. The 20 month old 'Rhyfel Orion', a third prize winner from Andrew Williams enjoyed a spirited following peaking at 2,600gns to John Mellin, Skipton, N. Yorks.

Bernard Llewellyn's trip from mid Wales proved successful when 'Carreg Oak' the Breed's Supreme Champion at the 2015 National Show and a host of other top awards levelled at 2,450gns to James Winnington, Derby.

Females enjoyed a brisk demand with quality being the important factor. Top price went to Eileen Hallfield's pre show Female Champion, 'Dunstall Jackpot' a 6 year old cow with heifer calf selling to David Howden's Buckinghamshire based herd at 2,800gns. The same purchaser taking other quality females at 1650gns for the Reserve Female Champion, 'Rhyfel Orchid' from Andrew Williams, 1,560gns for Stan Dixon's 'Long Ash Jabbaki', a 6 year old cow with bull calf and 1,450gns for 'Chalkney Quanika' a second calver, 6 months in calf from Brian Evans, Caersws.

Other cows with calves topped at 1,570gns from Mike & Sue Pope's Parchfields dispersal sale for 'Parchfields Frisson', a 10 year old cow with steer calf taken by Gordon Gilder, Cheltenham, Glos.

A major reduction sale from Phil and Susan Roberts Stockton based herd received a keen and enthusiastic following for maiden heifers topping at 940gns twice for 'Stockton Jade' by 'Tripps Illustrious' and 'Stockton Jenna' by 'Woolhope Jim' taken by Martin Gilder and N Bowen, Gloucester and Hereford respectively.

A 29 month steer belonging to Mr & Mrs D&A Blockley and weighing 750kg made £2/kg, selling to Martins Meats, Cheltenham.

GENUS CHARGES

For members of the Society that use semen from Society stocks please note that distribution charges from Genus to the Society went up on 1st September 2015. The Society passes these charges on at cost so unfortunately it means a rise in charges to members.

There will be a distribution charge of £3 per straw, with a minimum transaction charge of £25 and a maximum of £500 per transaction. This means if you order one straw you will be charged £25 to transfer it. This is to both Genus technicians and DIY flasks. The charge to third parties (ie your local technician who is not Genus) will rise to £80 for 1 to 20 straws and £80 + £3 per straw (capped at £500) for over 20 straws. All these prices will have VAT at 20% added to them. These charges are in addition to the cost of the semen itself.

Allow yourself plenty of time, especially if you are thinking of entering your bull for a show or sale and never assume the office has received the documentation!

Emailed registration forms or photos cannot be accepted as delivery cannot be guaranteed - the Society has pretty strong spam filters on the computer which sometimes do not allow big photo files through. We have had one incident this year where a member thought an email had been sent but the office had never received it so please post everything.

PERFORMANCE RECORDING

Cattle weight recording schemes originated as a way to disentangle the combined influences on an animal's appearance of the environment (feeding, management etc) and their genetics.

Over time a range of Estimated Breeding Values (EBVs) for traits relating to growth rate, carcass quality, ease of calving and maternal performance have been developed. These indicators of breeding potential are now an established part of pedigree beef production, increasing returns in all types of commercial beef enterprises – in both terminal sire and maternal breeds.

A pilot study has been started within the Longhorn breed looking at easy ways to incorporate pedigree and performance data into the genetic evaluations provided through Signet Breeding Services.

Two Longhorn herds are currently involved, Charles Sutcliffe's Tetford Herd and the Thomas families Barlings Herd. A preliminary BLUP run has already been completed and the Signet team are looking at ways to enhance the EBVs produced from this run.

Having established a recording protocol for the breed, Signet is seeking more herds that might be interested in supplying performance records (weights taken between birth and 500 days of age) for inclusion in the analysis.

PARENTAGE VERIFICATION

The purity of the Longhorn breed is one of it's major selling points and Council have decided that a random selection of heifers should be DNA sampled to verify their parentage. To this end the owner of each 100th female registered, starting from 1 January 2015, will be asked to provide a hair sample of the calf and both parents.

Should the sire not be on the holding then the current owner will be asked to provide a sample if one is not already held. DNA samples of all AI bulls are already held and if the bull is dead then a sibling or close relative will be sought.

TB COMPENSATION

Whilst the eradication of Bovine TB should be at the forefront of DEFRA's minds, it's inexorable creep across the country means more and more members are being affected. A quick look at the difference between the compensation you will receive for a registered pedigree animal and a non pedigree animal might make registration of all your calves a consideration. Retrospective pedigree registration of TB reactors is not permitted.

The table shows compensation for October 2015. It is updated each month.

The table is applicable to England only - Wales and Northern Ireland are on individual valuation and Scotland is TB free.
