Shrewsbury, Shropshire

One of England's finest mediæval towns. Shrewsbury is stuffed full of black and white buildings, ancients shuts and passageways. Around every corner you will encounter Shrewsbury's heritage and history. The River Severn almost encircles the town centre. It is the birthplace of Charles Darwin.

Shrewsbury is close to many well known attractions such as Acton Burnell Castle, Attingham Park and Ironbridge Gorge with it's bridge and museums.

> The Lord Hill Hotel is situated about 15 minutes walk from Shrewsbury town centre.

Farm visits

Our Saturday visit is by kind invitation of Messrs JE Barker & Sons, Great Berwick Farm, Shrewsbury.

The Barkers have farmed at Great Berwick for three generations and the farm used to be home to the Bardra herd of pedigree Holsteins. The herd was converted to organic in 1997 and due to family circumstances it was dispersed in 2004. Now well established as an organic farm, livestock were vital to the rotation and Longhorns were chosen to replace the diary herd to provide a unique, high value product to maximise returns. Steers and heifers unsuitable for breeding are taken through to finishing and are processed in the on-farm cutting plant. Recently the Barkers have started supplying their Longhorn beef to local online fine foods distributor Dukeshill in an exclusive deal. The 450 acre farm grows 30 acres of organic potatoes, 220 acres of grassland, 50 acres of game cover and the remainder is down to cereals. It is on river meadows adjacent to the River Avon. The tour will include the cattle, the cutting room and the opportunity to have a go at an informal stock judging competition.

Our Sunday visit is by kind invitation of Susan Roberts, Upper Stockton Farm, Marton, Welshpool, Powys

The Roberts have a 250 acre grassland farm straddling the Welsh and English borders. The farm is part owned and part tenanted and there is also 70 acres of woodland. Much of the land has been put into Countryside Stewardship. The Roberts were already running a large suckler herd and they decided to have a herd of Longhorns having picked up the odd beast at market. In 2001 the herd was taken out with Foot and Mouth and they have since restocked and have a herd of about 75 animals, running Wellhead Dempsey and Cayo Archie as stockbulls. A flock of Jacobs is also run- a plan to keep the children interested in farming that backfired! The tour will be around the cattle.



Recent sales
